Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar	(2014) 8 SCC 273	"Arrest is not mandatory."	Arrest requires reason/notice (<7 yr sentences).
Satender Kumar Antil v. CBI	 (2022) 10 SCC 51	"Structured bail guidelines."	Bail is standard for summons/charge-sheeted cases.
Dataram Singh v. State of	(2018) 3 SCC 22	"Presumption of innocence."	Accused presumed innocent until ..
